

North American 1.20m Team Championship

The North American Team Championship event is a championship format competition with teams representing invited Regions/States. The Teams will be comprised of 4 Horse/Rider Combinations, competing at the Modified Junior/Amateur level (1.20m). Each invited region will name a Chef D'Equipe. Riders may only ride on one team. In the event that a region cannot furnish 4 riders, they may substitute with a rider from another region. This event is open to Junior and Amateur riders. Riders may not have shown the same horse in classes above 1.35m or shown any horse in classes above 1.40m in the 2012 season.

Each Team will be associated with their Regional or State Horse Shows Association. These associations will be issued the invitations and are responsible for determining how riders/horses qualify for their respective teams. An alternate is recommended to accompany each team to ensure that all teams have four riders. The alternate may compete as an individual, as may other horse/rider combinations not competing on a team. Additional regions may request invitations.

Teams representing California region 1 & 2 will be selected off of the PCHA standings in the Modified Junior Amateur standings as of Sept 1 2012.

Class Format

This event will be run in the championship format.

Day 1 Table III. All riders compete. Placings converted to faults and will be carried forward. This round will be held in the Annex Arena.

Day 2 Table II. Two rounds over the same course. For the Team competition each team will discard their high score. The winning team will be the team with the lowest combined scores from the

two rounds. This competition to be held in the International Arena. Presentation to the winning teams..

Day 3 Table II. Open to the top (20) horse/rider combinations including all ties. In the case of a tie for the overall championship there will be a jump off. This competition to be held in the International Arena.
